Option 1

Imagine you have travelled back to the Stone Age. Write a postcard home to tell everyone about your visit.

You can do this in your homework book.



Option 2

Design a menu for a typical day's meals in Stone Age times.

Remember you cannot just pop to the shops to buy the food.

You would need to hunt or gather every ingredient for every meal.



Option 3

Make up your own fact sheet or leaflet/poster on one area of Stone Age life.

You can choose from houses, tools, food or animals.

Include lots of interesting facts and pictures/diagrams.

Option 4

In the early Stone Age people lived in caves. If you lived in a cave what would it look like?

Be as imaginative and creative as you like?
Could you make a 3D model ?



Option 5

Create a word search all about Stone Age life.



Option 6

Tell a story using typical cave art paintings and drawings.



Option 7

Make a junk model of a typical Stone Age tool.

Option 8

Write word problems using all four mathematical operations.

For example

The hunters catch 6 deer on a Monday then 2 deer every day for the rest of the week. How many deers have they caught in total?
