## General Reminders...

- Any letters or reply slips, which need to be returned, can be put in your child's book bag. The children are expected to check them each morning and give things in before the morning register.
- The children will have a weekly spelling test on a Friday. Children will be given spellings to learn on a Friday to take home and will be tested the following week.
- Homework will generally be a piece of literacy but may also include topic work and research depending on what is being taught that week. It will be given out on a Friday and is expected to be handed in by the following **Wednesday**. All the class are registered on 'MyMaths' and SPAG.com so some homework will be done online and monitored by both class teachers.
