



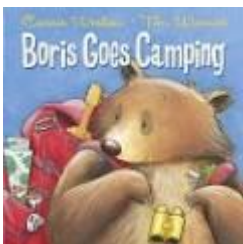
Year 1 Class Newsletter Summer 1 2025

Reading in Year 1

Your child has been given a book and a reading diary to bring home and read with an adult. Whenever your child reads please ensure the diary is dated and signed with any relevant comments. Daily reading is essential to ensure they progress well, aim for 10 minutes each day. Books will be changed on Tuesday and Friday. Ensure their book is in school on these days. The children will also read in class, 1:1 or in a guided group with the Teacher or Teaching assistant.



This term we are using the film Marshmallows in English and Boris goes camping.

Routines

PE will be on Monday. Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school all week and that all items are clearly labelled. Earrings should not be worn for P.E so we advise they should be removed on the day of the lesson.

Any letters or reply slips, which need to be returned, can be put in your child's book bag. The children are expected to check them each morning and give things in before the morning register. Bags will be checked by us on Tuesday and Friday.

Homework will be set to support learning of phonics and in preparation for the Phonics screening during the week beginning 9th June. The homework will be online videos for the children to actively participate in. Homework will be set on Friday and should be completed throughout the week in addition to reading practice.
