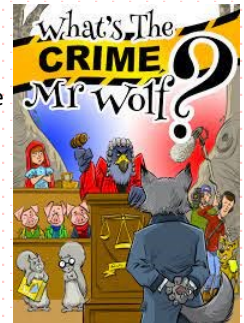
Lancashire Adult Learning for organising.
