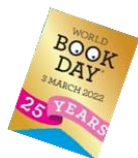

This week saw the return of our reading group. The group is looking forward to inspiring a love of reading in school. They are currently planning to launch an exciting competition in the Summer Term.

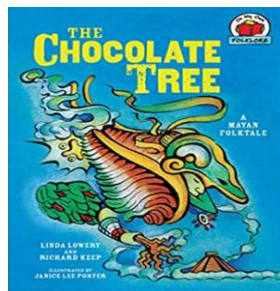
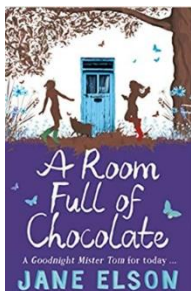
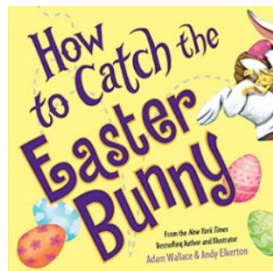
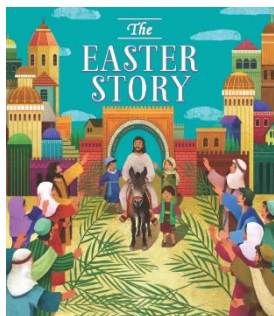
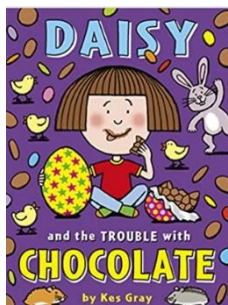
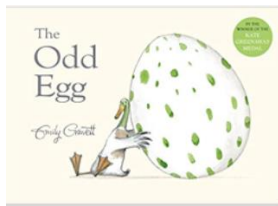
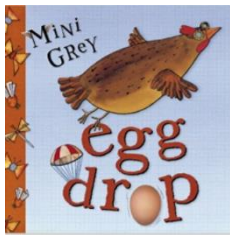
