World Book Day 2021.

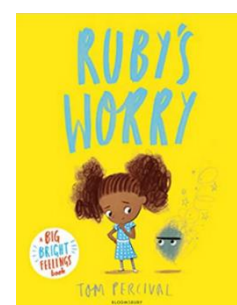
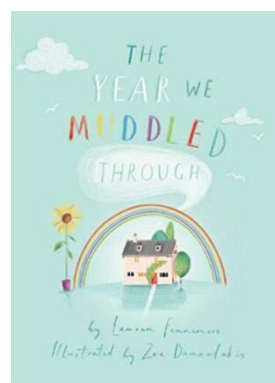
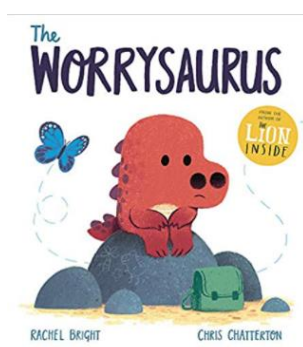
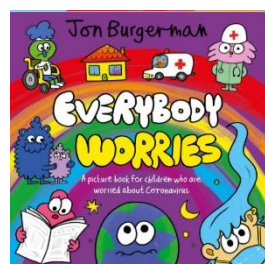
