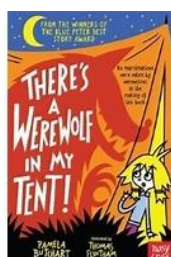
We caught up with some of our 'Masked Reader' World Book Day competition winners to find out what book they had chosen with their tokens.



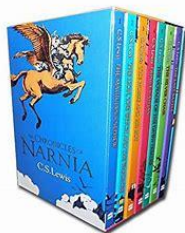

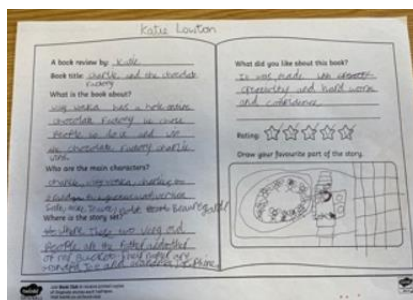

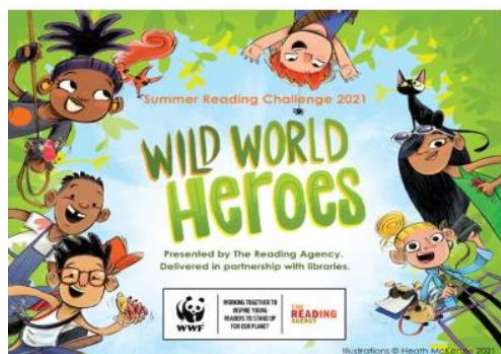
'The Page Turners' Book Review Competition
