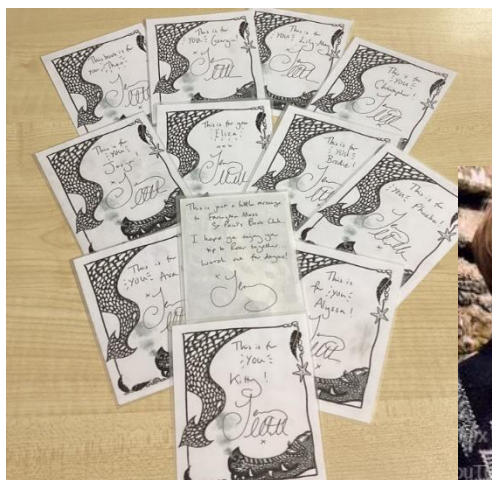
"Reading is dreaming with eyes wide open."
